

Secret Frequency Crew Biography

Who is the Secret Frequency Crew? We're not exactly sure anymore. We know their birth names: Matthew Brown, Matt Friedman, and Adrian Michna, but their whereabouts recently have been shadowy and sporadic. Last year in Toronto several witnesses from the National Artichoke Foundation claimed to have seen them in action. In fact, it was alleged that they were responsible for creating a near riot at the NAF Regional Leaf Removal semi-finals. In a press conference following the event, publicist Tommy Nuroq denied any and all allegations. "The SFC make music and only music. They respect and love the NAF and would have no interest in inciting a riot, anybody who knows them *knows this...*"

The Secret Frequency Crew's story actually began in 1988. They first met at the infamous NAF World Artichoke Sauce Dipping finals. Never had the competition seen such young finalists. Shutting out all of the returning veterans, it was arguably the most historic event in all of the professional artichoke world's 60 years of competition. Tired with the post season media frenzy and the politics of the artichoke circuit, they decided to retire from the NAF and turn to other careers.

Adrian Michna, son of a Chinese fashion designer, began work on what would later become his widely acclaimed teal sweatpants line. Matthew Brown, son of the world famous barber Ridiglio Theophus Brown, began training in his father's salon, which led to his groundbreaking thesis on symbiotic hair clippings sweeping devices. Matthew Friedman along with several silent investors started his international modeling agency, Waif Inc.

After years of success with their separate careers, the former NAF World Champions and future members of the SFC met by chance late one night in upstate NY at a David Hasselhof look-a-like contest. It was there, backstage with contest winner and mutual friend, Tommy Nuroq, that their friendship was rekindled. The SFC quickly made arrangements to go on an extended world vacation to discuss the possibilities of joining forces to make music. During that summer of 1995, they coined the name Secret Frequency Crew while camping on the coast of the Kamchatka Peninsula (part of the Russian Federation) along the Bering Sea. Late one evening in the city of Petropavlovsk-Kamchatskiy, over a fine feast of Kazakh noodles, cabbage rolls, and fine regional wine, they agreed to return to upstate New York and write music together.

Upon returning to New York they found that their ongoing careers were getting too much in the way of their music compositions. In order to focus solely on music they relocated to Wainae, Hawaii and recorded 'The Underwater Adventure-Hop Secret Treasure' which was released on Counterflow recordings. They then moved to Miami to write more music and jump on the thriving mail-order business bandwagon. It was during this prosperous time that they wrote and recorded 'Forest of the Echo Downs' in their custom built indoor forest studio, 'The Black Moss Cave'. Currently they are pursuing business options and reviewing silent investor proposals in Okinawa.
